Vending Techs

Assist certified routers in their daily duties, including but not limited to:

- Operate motor vehicle to transport materials and equipment
- Monitor shelf life and sales of products to minimize spoilage losses
- Maintain accurate records of truck inventory and product movement to machine inventory
- Resolves customer issues concerning vending products and machine malfunctions
- Ensure proper care in the use and maintenance of equipment and supplies
- Works Tuesday through Saturday 5:30 am – until routes are complete and rotating weekend shifts. Work days average 8 – 10 hours per day
- Perform miscellaneous janitorial duties as assigned

Minimum Skills:

- A high school diploma or GED
- Possession of a valid driver's license
- A good motor vehicle record
- Pre-employment physical
- Experience operating a truck
- Ability to read, understand, follow, and enforce safety procedures
- Ability to make independent, routine procedural decisions
- Ability to identify and resolve routine operational problems
- Knowledge of customer service standards and procedures
- Know the City of Atlanta streets well.

WORKING CONDITIONS AND PHYSICAL EFFORT:

Work involves moderate exposure to unusual elements, such as extreme temperatures, dirt, dust, fumes, smoke, unpleasant orders, and/or loud noises.

Considerable physical activity. Requires heavy physical work; heavy lifting, pushing, or pulling required of objects up to 50 pounds. Physical work is a primary part (more than 90%) of the job.
